

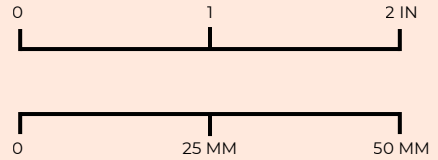

RING SIZING GUIDE

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- Begin by printing this page.
- Set the page scaling to 100% in your print settings and use standard 8.5 x 11 inch paper.
- Once printed, use a ruler to confirm the paper size in the box to the right.

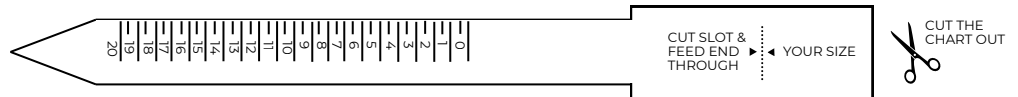
FIND YOUR FIT

METHOD 1: PRINT A RING SIZER

What you'll need:

- Scissors

- Cut out the ring sizer and the slot as instructed.
- Wrap the paper ring sizer snugly around the base of the intended finger so that the numbers are visible and insert the pointed end through the slit you made in the sizer according to the cut lines.
- Note the number that lines up with the slit. This is your ring size! Remember that quarter sizes are also available if your sizer indicates that you are between sizes.



METHOD 2: PRINT A RING SIZER

What you'll need:

- A ring that fits the desired finger

- Choose a ring that correctly fits the intended finger.
- Lay the ring over each size circle within the chart until you can closely match the inside edge to one of the circles. This is your size. If the ring falls between two sizes, contact us to order a quarter size between.

RING SIZE CONVERSION CHART

Millimeters are equivalent to the interior circumference of the corresponding ring size.
